TALK: There are lots of different versions of doll's houses today where big things have been made small enough to play with. Do you have a doll's house? Did anyone in your bubble have a doll's house when they were little? What about a Masters of the Universe Skeletor Castle or a Polly Pockets or Sylvania Families? What do you love about having a whole world to play with at a small scale?

DO: Design just one room for a miniature play house of your choosing. It does not have to be a fairy doll's house - it can be anything. **Remember** - the amazing thing about the fairy castle in this video is the detail.

1. Choose the type of room you will design - kitchen, bathroom, bedroom, TV room.
2. Design the furniture first - what do you need?
3. Now choose what colour the walls and floor will be - what materials will you make them out of?
