

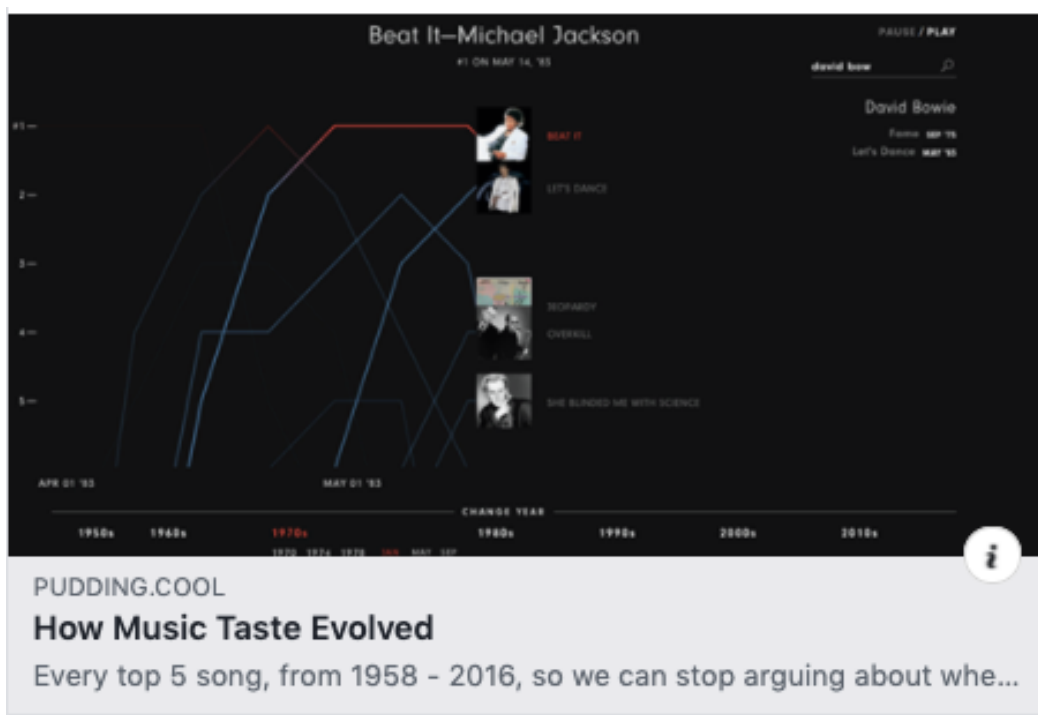
SCHOOL KIT AT HOME

WATCH: Polygraph which lists every top 5 song from 1954-2016 and is produced by [The Pudding](#). (you'll need to use the date function at the bottom of the screen to move around).

TALK: Talk to the people in your bubble. What were there favourite songs when they were teenagers? Look up the song that was #1 in the week you were born. Do this for everyone in your bubble. Who is the best in your bubble at remembering all the words to songs.

DO: Identify an adult to be your test subject (they will need to tell you the year that they were born). Work out what year your adult was 10 yrs old, the year they were 13, the year they were 18 and the year they were 25.

1. Make a prediction: Which year of music will your test subject know the most words for - 10,13,18 or 25?
2. Put headphones on your test subject but face the computer towards you.
3. Instruct your name any of the songs they hear.
4. Start with January of the year your test subject turned 10 years old.



5. How much of the year of music can they sing along to?
6. Repeat for the other years.
7. Review your prediction - were you correct?
