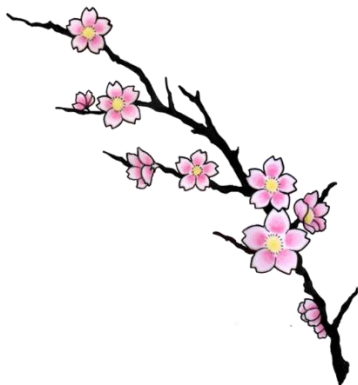


1. Spring begins this Wednesday, 1st September. What will be the date of the Wednesday a fortnight later?
