502 Child Protection

Rationale

All children are valued, respected and are safe from any form of abuse

Purposes

- 1. To ensure that children have a safe and respectful learning environment.
- 2. An environment is fostered that enables children to comfortably discuss issues with teachers.
- 3. That if a child at Ōmata School is abused, shows signs of abuse or abuse is disclosed, the school has a clear legal responsibility to disclose to the appropriate agency and respond in a supportive, appropriate manner.

Guidelines

- 1. Ōmata School has programmes as part of the health curriculum to educate children about many aspects of health and well-being.
- 2. Teachers have the training and resources to identify and respond to children's needs with regard to the wider aspect of their learning and safety.
- 3. That adults in the school environment are sensitive to children so that children are able to feel heard.
- 4. If abuse is identified/disclosed, safety of the child/children is paramount, the Principal is informed, the school interacts with legally obligated agencies and where appropriate, discussed with parents to ensure the most support for the child/children. All suspected and actual cases are acted on and documented.
 - Refer to 502a Procedure Child Protection
- 5. Parents are advised that they must have a clear police vet when they apply to assist as parent helps or on any school activity where they may be supervising students.
- 6. Any person employed or engaged by the school that will work with children are safety checked as required under the child protection legislation before appointment.
